## ***Current Status of our building***

Portions of the lower level of the church remain closed. The Downstairs Parish Hall, the kitchen, and the open area between these are safe to use (*chalice bearers may access the vestments closet from the stairwell on the south side of the sanctuary to retrieve robes.*) The Youth Room, the 4<sup>th</sup> – 6<sup>th</sup> grade classroom, and the 1<sup>st</sup> – 3<sup>rd</sup> grade classroom are cleaned and awaiting an air quality test before The Nursery, Pre-school/Kindergarten Classroom, the Boiler Room and the Men's and Women's Bathrooms have been sealed off due to the presence of asbestos. We have contracted with a company to complete the asbestos abatement and removal task. The work is scheduled to begin on Thu. 3/14 and be completed within a week.

After the asbestos abatement is completed, we will be able to move forward with repairing the interior of the building that was damaged in the explosion and purchasing and installing a new boiler. For everyone's safety, these areas will not be accessible until ALL the work is completed. We currently do not know how long that will take.

We will continue to use space heaters to heat our building until a new boiler is operational. We will also continue to let our water run in the facets to keep the pipes from freezing.

Please check below to view which groups will be meeting and which will be postponed until we can re-configure our space.

Please continue to pray for TLC and this situation. There is still much to be determined and figure out before everything is restored. Also continue to praise God that no one was seriously injured!
